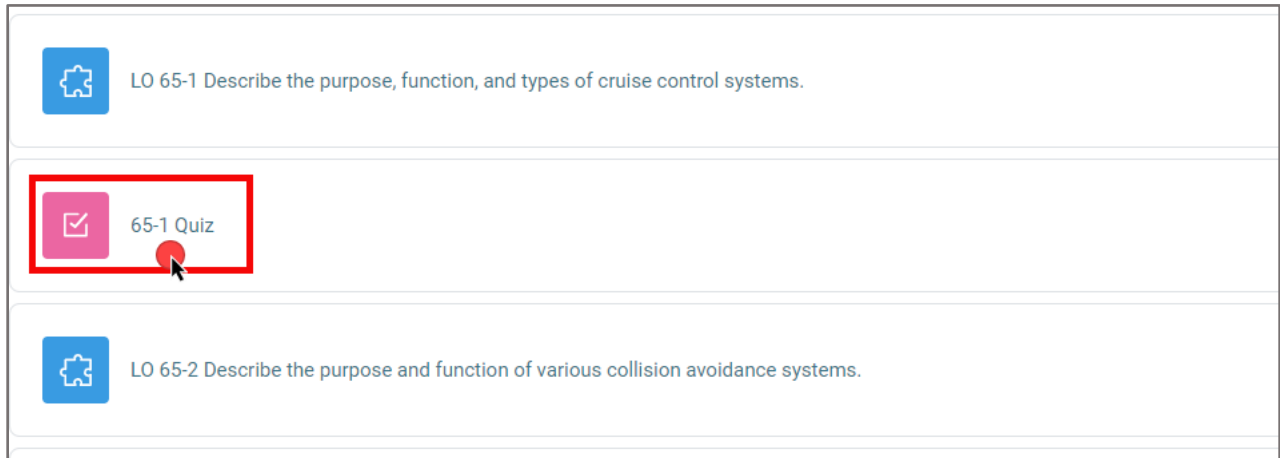


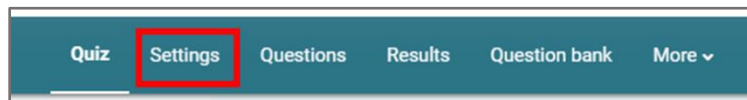
# How to Change the Number of Attempts on a Quiz

*This document contains instructions on how to set a limit on the number of attempts allowed for a quiz.*

1. Log in to your CDX account as an instructor, and then navigate to the desired course and the desired quiz.



2. On the quiz page, Click **Settings** in the menu at the top. .



3. Scroll down and click **Grade** to expand the Grade section. Modify **Attempts allowed** to the desired number of attempts you want to allow for that quiz.
