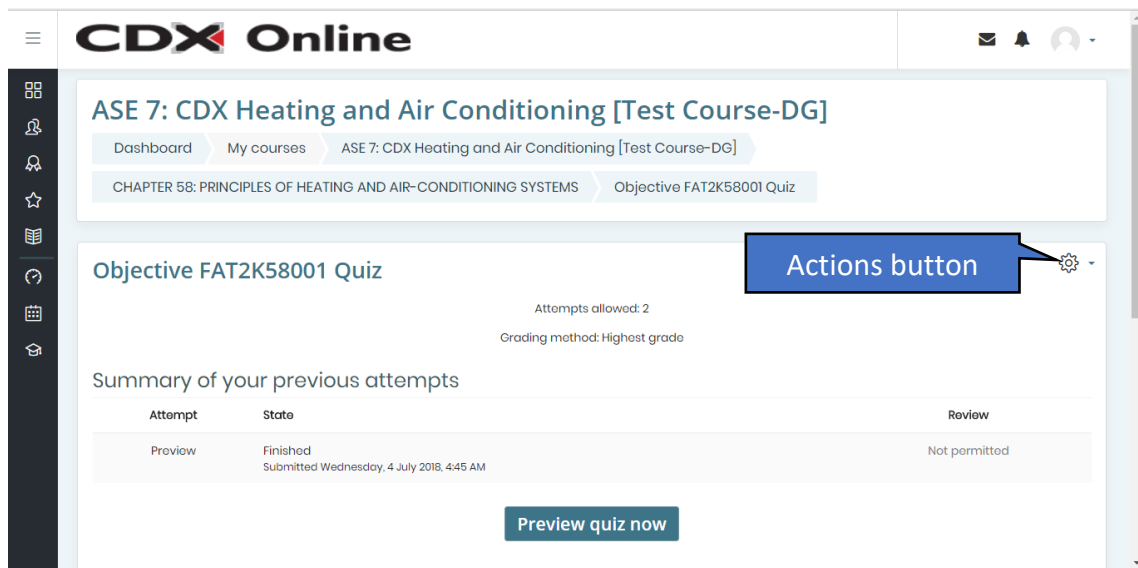



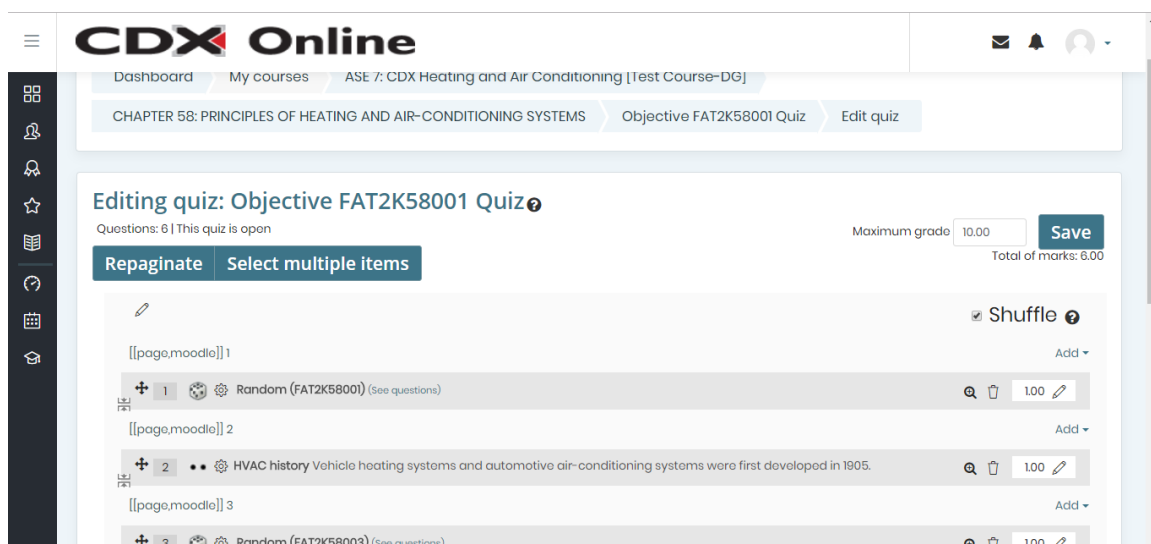
How do I change how a quiz is displayed?

You can change the way a quiz is displayed to students to show more or fewer questions per page, to rearrange questions, and to turn Shuffle mode off or on.

1. Log in to your CDX account as an instructor and navigate to the desired course.
2. On the course page, navigate to the quiz you want to make changes to, then click the quiz name. The quiz page opens, displaying summary information such as attempts allowed and grading method, and an **Actions button** for working with the quiz.

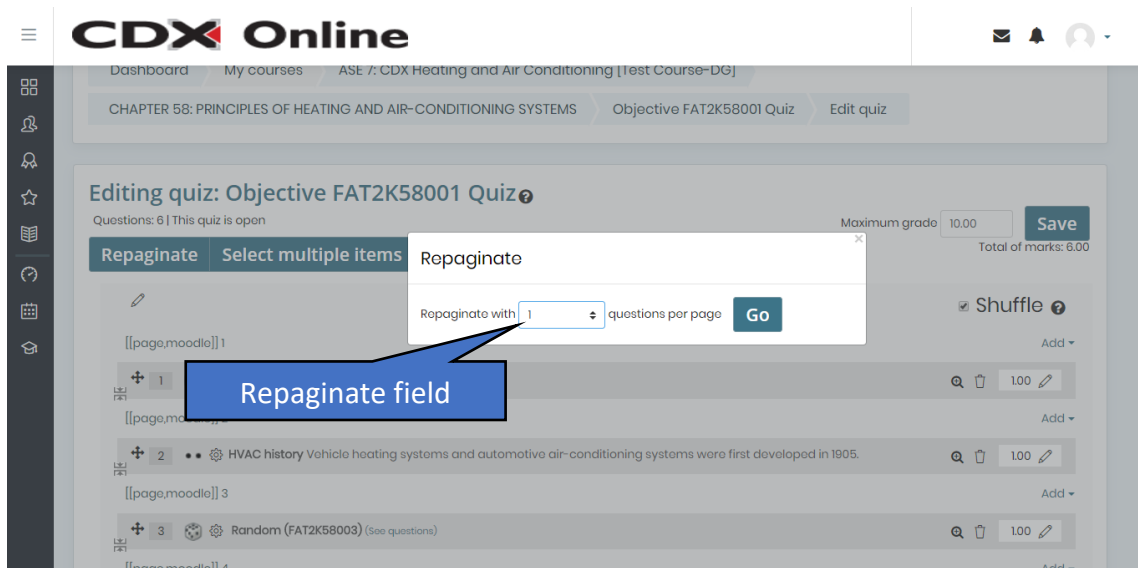



3. In the top right corner of the quiz page, click the **Actions button** , then click **Edit quiz**. The quiz opens for editing, showing how many questions are displayed per page, icons for editing and rearranging the questions, whether Shuffle mode is off or on, and details about each question.

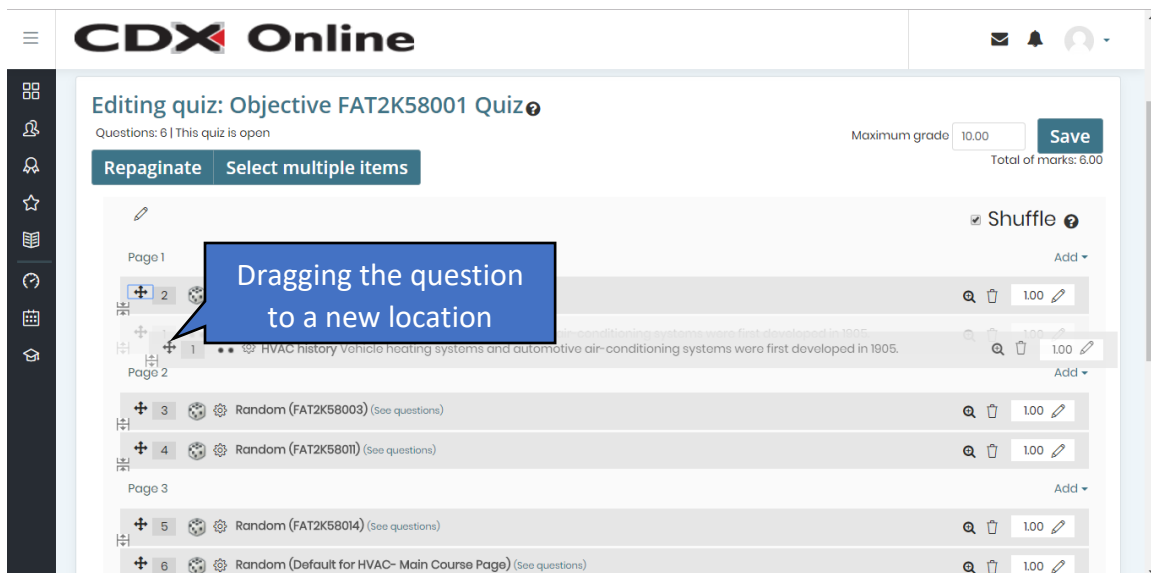


How do I change how a quiz is displayed?

- To change how many questions are displayed on a page, click the **Repaginate** button in the upper left corner of the page. In the dialog box that opens, click the **Repaginate with field**, choose a different number—for example, 2—then click **Go**.

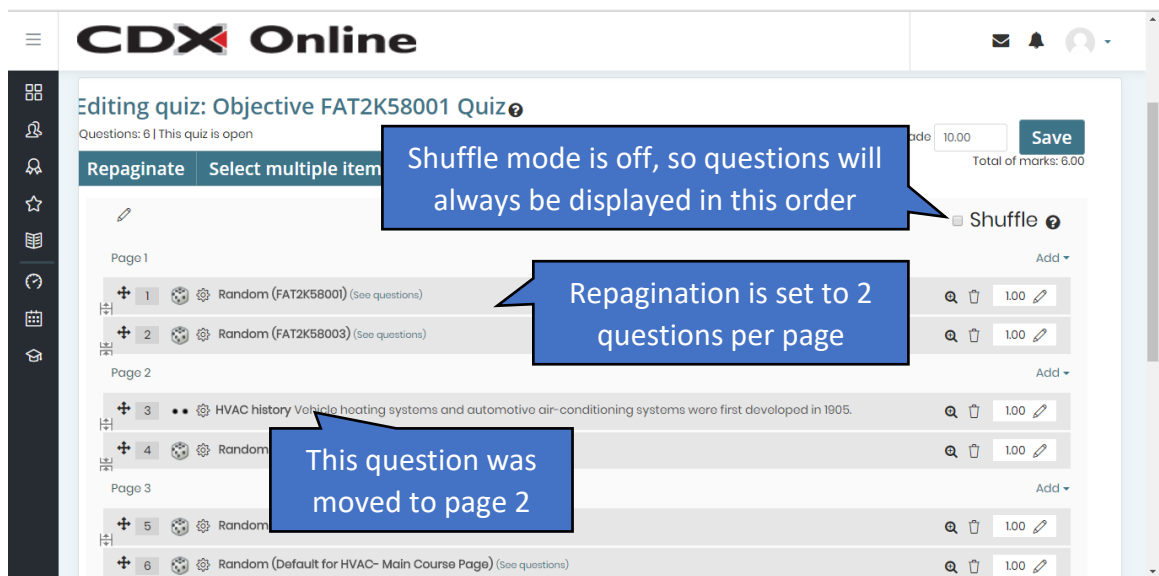



- To move a question to a new location, click and hold the **Move icon**  next to the question, then drag it to a new location. Release the mouse button to complete the move. You can move questions within the page or to a new page in the quiz.



How do I change how a quiz is displayed?

- To turn Shuffle mode off or on, click the **Shuffle checkbox** in the top right corner of the quiz page. A checkmark means the order of questions will be shuffled each time a student attempts the quiz. Removing the checkmark sets the questions to appear in a specific order.



- When you're finished changing the way the quiz displays, click **Save** in the upper right corner of the page, then click the **Course icon**  in the system drawer on the left to return to your course.
