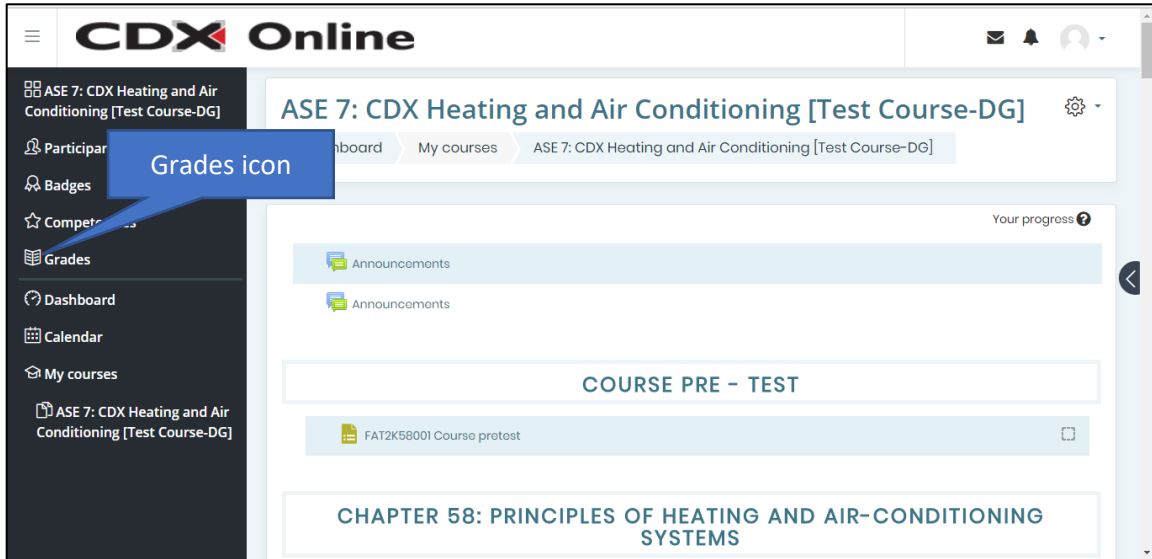



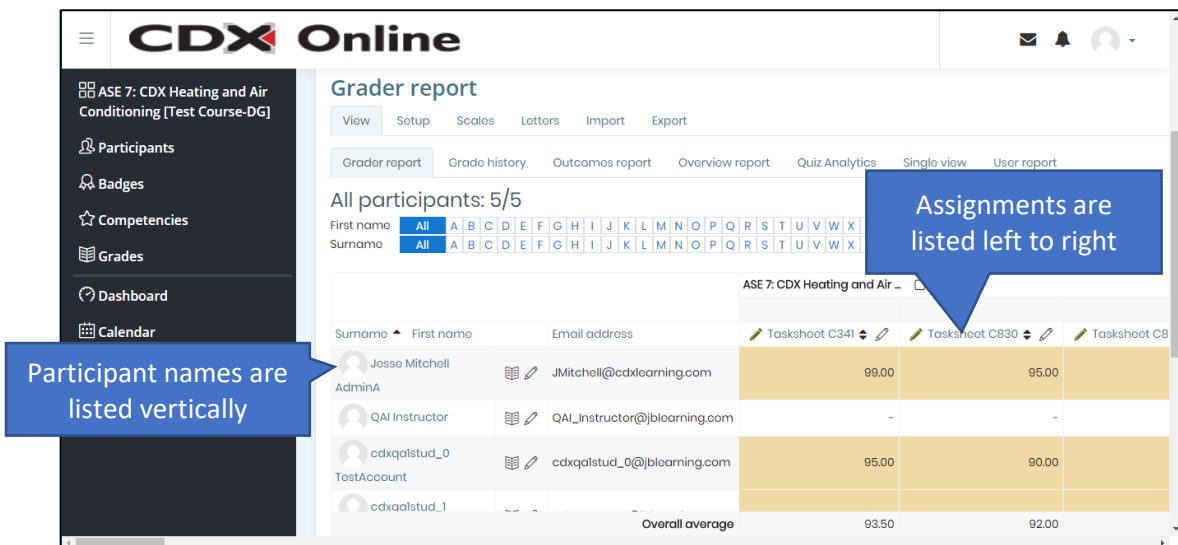
How do I see and change student attempts on a quiz?

You can view a student's attempts on a quiz, and make changes including grades and feedback, by accessing the quiz using the gradebook.

1. Log in to your CDX account as an instructor and navigate to the desired course.




2. In the system drawer, click **Grades**—or, if the system drawer is minimized to show only icons, click the **Grades icon** . The gradebook for the course opens in Grader report view, which lists student names down the left and all assignments across the top.





3. Scroll to the name of the quiz you want to make changes to.

How do I see and change student attempts on a quiz?

- When you're finished, click the **Show Report** button, then scroll down to see the current results. You can see which students have attempted the quiz, when they attempted it, how long they spent, their overall quiz grade, and the points they received for each question.

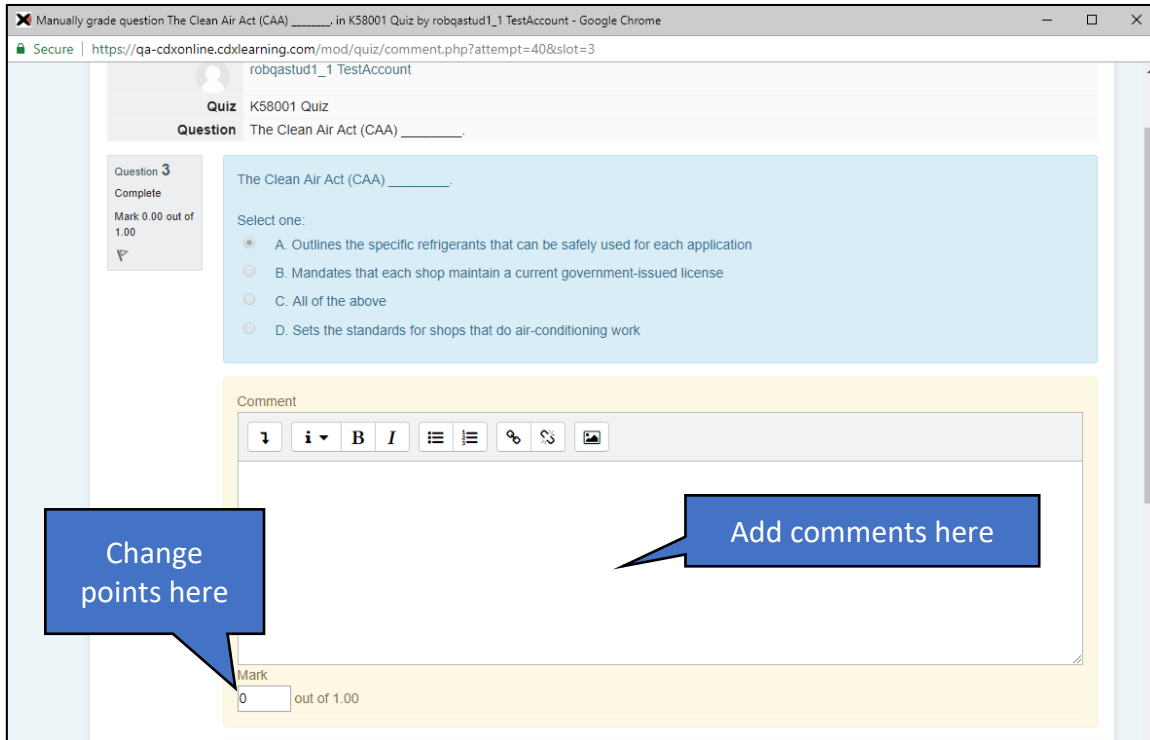
