
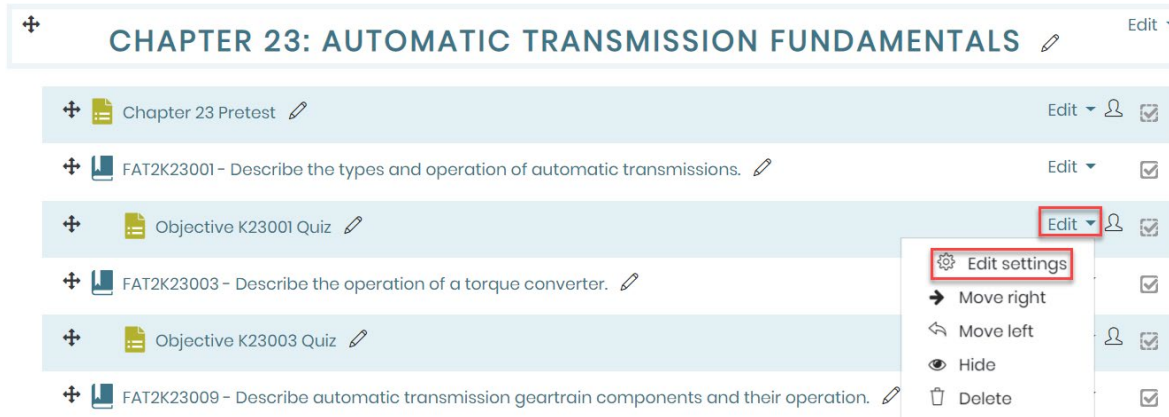


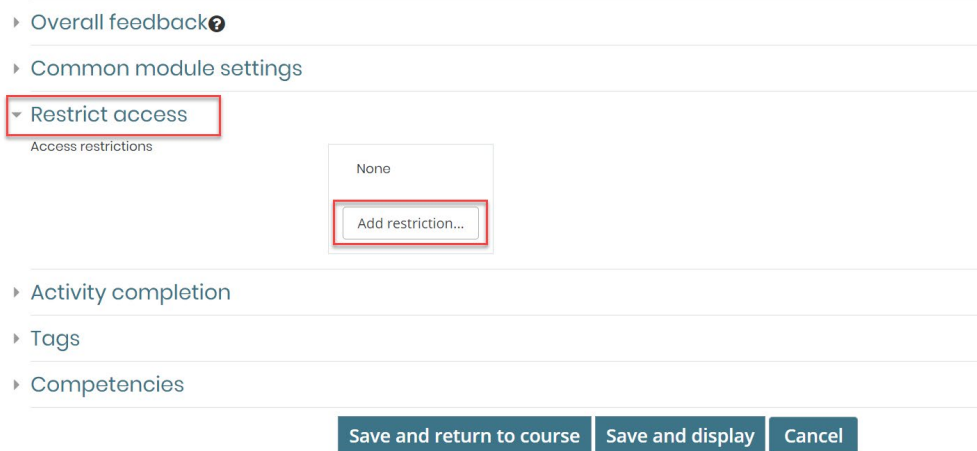
How Can I Gate Student Progress or Apply Access Requirements?

1. Navigate to the course page that contains the items for which you would like to gate student progress or access in the course. Click the **Actions** button  and then select “Turn editing on.”
2. Find the activity or resource for which you wish to apply a requirement or gate to. To the right of this item, find and click the “Edit” menu. Then click the first option here to “Edit settings.”

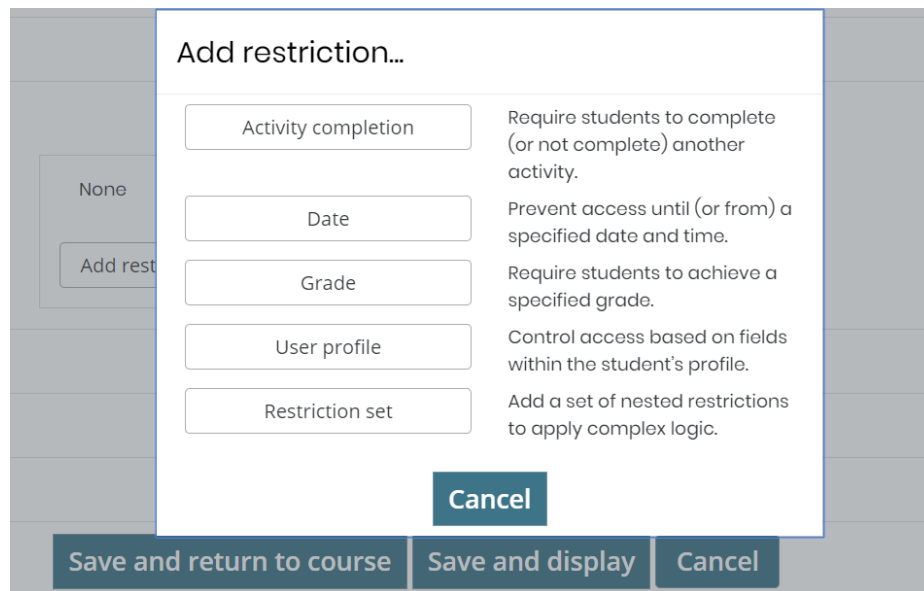
3. Access restrictions will always be found towards the bottom of the item’s settings page. Scroll to this section, labelled “Restrict access,” and click to expand it. Then click the “Add restriction” button to select your gating method.

5. Restriction types

- An Activity completion restriction will make student access to this item dependent on their completion status of any other course item of your choosing. You can select a different course item that students' access will depend on from the dropdown menu, and then choose the status required for its completion.

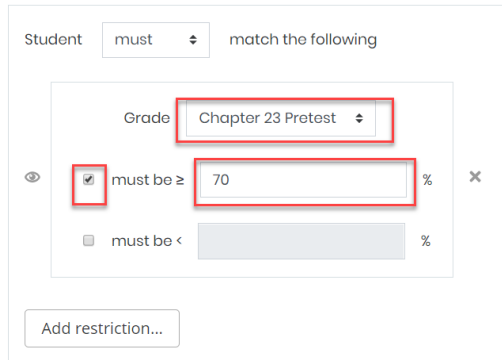

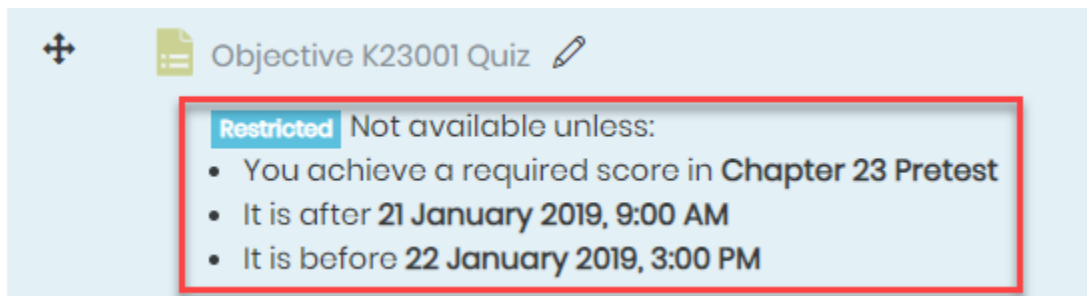
