




Begin by logging into your account at cdxauto.com and navigating to your CDX home page.

Then, from the navigation on the left, click on the course that you would like to create a custom quiz in.




Then, from that same navigation, click on the new Course Home button.






In the top right corner of the page, find and click on the gear icon to open your course options. Then select Turn Editing On

Your page will reload and you will see more editing options have been enabled.




Scroll to the bottom of the list of assignments, then click on the Add an Activity or Resource option. From the menu that appears, select Quiz, then click on the Add button.






This will bring you to the page where you can create a new quiz and adjust it's settings.

Give your quiz a name, and adjust any settings you may want to change. For a detailed walk through of your CDX Quiz settings please see our separate video on Quiz Settings. You can also click the Grey (?) for information on each setting.



Once you have adjusted any quiz settings, scroll to the bottom of the page and click on Save and Display.


You will then be brought into your quiz and see a warning message telling you that you have no questions in your quiz.





To add questions, click on the Edit Quiz option.

From the Editing Quiz page, find and click on the Add Button<sup>1</sup> on the right side of the page. This will expand a menu with three ways to add questions to your assignment.



A New Question<sup>2</sup> will allow you to create your own questions for your assignment.

From Question Bank<sup>3</sup> will let you browse our premade question banks and select the questions you would like to use.

And finally, A Random Question<sup>4</sup>, will allow you to set the quiz to pull random questions from our question bank for each student.
